Subject: IMPORTANT NOTICE: PPMI/PIVOT Update

Dear Agency Partners,

Thank you for your continued support of our Post Payment Modernization Initiative (PPMI) and the development of the Payment Information View of Transactions (PIVOT) system. As you are aware, the original vision for PPMI was to modernize and automate the post payment business processes and technologies of four legacy post payment systems. Through our agency engagement efforts, we have learned that some of our reengineering efforts will take some agencies years to adopt and require funding that may not be available until other agency priorities are addressed. Additionally, Fiscal Service has recently had technology decommissioning mandates emerge that must be achieved within specified timeframes.

For these reasons, we have decided to no longer pursue the reengineering of cancellations with the standard cancellation file (SCF) and will instead deliver your cancellation information according to your agency's legacy file requirements. This change in direction is intended to deliver a solution with a much lower customer agency impact, so agencies will be better positioned to meet our implementation timelines. This adjustment also better positions Fiscal Service to decommission the legacy systems in the specified timeframes. As such, we have ceased development and test activities aligned to the PIVOT SCF and related accounting changes. We will still need your engagement in the future to confirm PIVOT generated files (in the legacy format) meet your legacy specifications. PPMI has entered a requirements analysis phase and will come back to you with an updated roadmap and engagement schedule later this year.
