Why use ITS.gov?

- Secure, web-based application for making international payments
- USD and foreign currencies
- 200+ countries / 100+ currencies
- Free to federal agencies

Why use ITS.gov?

- Payment mechanisms:
 - EFT
 - Check
 - Western Union
- All payments are OFAC screened

Why use ITS.gov?

- ITS.gov can process:
 - Monthly benefit payments
 - Foreign payroll
 - Vendor payments
 - Miscellaneous payments
- Currency Rate Options: Spot or Advanced
- Various foreign exchange options available
 - Fixed to variable, variable to fixed, and fixed to fixed

When Do I Use ITS.gov?

- Foreign currency payment
- SWIFT Code / IBAN
- USD payment to a foreign country
- Receiving foreign currency collections

ITS.gov and Collections

- ITS.gov can be used to **receive** foreign currency payments, including:
 - Registration fees
 - Travel / program reimbursements
 - Grant payments
 - Inspection fees
 - Security fees
- USD payments via Credit Gateway (CIR)
- Support provided by ITS.gov staff at the Kansas City Financial Center

 - Country expansion for IDD payments
 - Direct Voucher System
 - New PPS interface planned for FY 2016
