Allows the Agency to:


- Create payment schedules


Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) Security

“i-Key” – USB device used for user authentication & schedule certification




“PIV” – Smartcard used for user authentication & schedule certification


PIV Migration Timeline





Basic Functionality and Process Flow






Eliminate need for a Connect:Direct connection
